Men's Space invites men aged 50+ to meet, socialise, share interests and stories. Volunteers get to know all our participants and lead discussions while working with other volunteers to encourage everyone to join in and have fun.

Your Responsibilities

- Assist the Men's Space Volunteer Host in leading discussions and preparing resources.
 - Welcome new participants, sign them in, and encourage them to join in with discussions.
 - Help develop the group based on participant feedback and on occasion arrange and facilitate guest speakers.
 - Offer and serve clients tea, coffee, or cold drinks.
 - Set up the room, resources and tidy up after the session.
 - Liaise with the Community Engagement Team, providing feedback and reporting problems.
 - Follow our policies and procedures, attend relevant training sessions, and maintain appropriate boundaries.
